

## **LOCAL GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT**

### **(Municipal Corporation)**

#### **Engineering Wing**

##### **B&R Circle**

During 2018-19 total 182.68 Kms length of Road/Parking has been re- carpeted and PCC tiles/paver blocks have been laid in the total area of 37000 sqm. 03 No of community centres in sector-33, 43 & 50 were constructed. Construction of one Dispensary in Sector 50 was completed. One new green belt developed in Sector 50. Renovation of cremation ground in Sector-25 was carried out and completed. Construction of Smart City office in Sector-17 was completed and made functional. One open air theatre completed in sector 48. 80 open air gyms installed in various park/green belts of the city. 140 nos. playing equipments were installed in different gardens/parks/green belts of the city. 260 dead and dry trees were removed. 56 high mast lights installed at various locations in city. 01 No LPG waste furnace has been provided in cremation ground of sector-25.

#### **Public Health Services**

Two Water works/pumps house of 35 MGD were commissioned at Jandpur and Sector 39, Chandigarh. One Water treatment plant of 15 MGD capacity was commissioned at Water works Sector – 39, Chandigarh. One Sewage treatment plant of 5 MGD capacity has been commissioned at Maloya Chandigarh. 22 nos Tubewells installed and re-bored. 3 nos new boosting stations commissioned. 27 kms length of water supply pipeline replaced/ laid. 8 kms length of sewer line replaced/laid. 25 nos of toilets constructed in different locations of the city.

#### **Sanitation Wing**

- During Swachh Survekshan 2019, Municipal Corporation Chandigarh has been declared India's Best State Capital/UT in Solid Waste Management, 2nd Runner up for Best Citizen Led Initiative Solid Waste Management: Cultivation of Oyster Mushrooms from Agriculture and Kitchen Waste in used Plastic Bottles and stood 20th amongst 4237 ULBs in all India Ranking by Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, New Delhi.
- Chandigarh got 3rd position in Swacchta Survekshan, 2018.
- A new project of window composting has also been started at Dumping Ground having capacity 250-300 MTPD.
- The total No. 23,866 of stray dogs have been sterilized and vaccinated against rabies upto 30th April 2019. The total No.13709 of doses in stray dogs have been inoculated in weekly camps against rabies since October 2010 to 18th May 2019.

- The Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has constructed Civil Dispensary in Sector-50 and the same has been inaugurated/started on 03.01.2019 for public health facilities.
- The Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has started online CRS system to issue death certificate at cremation grounds (Sector 25 & Housing board).
- Chandigarh Solid Waste Management Policy 2018 was notified vide No.F-II(9)-2018/13581 dated 04.09.2018.
- Municipal Corporation Chandigarh Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws, 2019 notified vide No. F-II(9)-2018/4678 dated 18.03.2019.
- To make city free from insanitation & enforcing sanitation, the violators were issued 4338 sanitation challans and fine realized for Rs. 8,74,000/-.
- The 26 Bulk Waste Generators are handling their wet waste on-site.

### **Tax Branch**

- The Tax Branch has recovered Rs. 50.58 crore from 57,164 assesses during the financial year 2018-19 as property tax on residential and commercial lands & buildings falling within MC limits in comparison to the last year recovery of Rs.42.30 Crore.
- Due to printing of demand bills of assessment year 2019-20 by the MC itself, Rs.45.00 lac per year will now be saved, which were earlier paid to NIELIT.
- The online payment facility for paying residential as well as commercial property tax has been started through Sampark website portal i.e. sampark.chd.nic.in.

### **Smart City Projects**

- Finalized recruitment to make CSCL effective and independent.
- New Office of CSCL got constructed and made functional.
- Many pending issues of project got resolved in BOD meeting.
- Tenders got floated for Public Bike Sharing, 24\*7 water supply and smart water meters.
- Participated actively in 100 days digital payments campaign for Smart Cities.

### **DEENDAYAL ANTYODAYA YOJANA-NATIONAL URBAN LIVELIHOOD MISSION (DAY-NULM)**

- Approx. 1771 urban poor beneficiaries have been trained under Skill Training in more than 26 skill trades. 819 candidates have been provided certification to the urban poor beneficiaries and stipend through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT). 563 placements have been given as wage employment/self employment to the urban poor beneficiaries in various companies/sectors vis-à-vis IT & ITes, Retail sector, Service Sector etc. by Brand Mandi, Aerial Telecom Solutions Private Limited, Health Tech, Bio Tech Limited, IKAY Human Solutions Limited, JUGNOO Meals, PVR Cinemas, SWIGGY, DOMINOS etc

- Under the Social Mobilization and Institutional development (SM&ID) component, 25 Self Help groups have been formed including 250 EWS urban women beneficiaries. 17 Self Help Groups (SHGs) have been given revolving fund @ Rs. 10,000/- per group amounting to Rs. 1.70 lacs for inter-lending. 1 (one) Area Level Federation, Small Flats Dhanas comprising of 13 SHGs including 130 women has been registered by Registrar of Firms and Societies, U.T Chandigarh. 36 Financial Literacy and Counselling Camps covering 1000 beneficiaries organized with assistance of four FLCC Coordinator vis-à-vis SBI, PNB Punjab and Sind Bank & HDFC.
- Under the Self Employment Programme ( SEP) component of DAY-NULM, out of 122 sponsored cases 67 loans have been sanctioned by various banks for setting up of micro enterprises and MUDRA convergence including different activities vis-a-vis carpentry shop, cloth work, food stall, Stitching, Cosmetic work, Karyanawork, Stationery Shop, Fruit and Vegetable selling work etc. An amount of Rs. 71.60 lacs has been disbursed as loan.
- Under the Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) component -Chief Architect, U.T. Chandigarh has approved one Site at Sector 43, Chandigarh for construction of new shelter for urban homeless.

## **Vendor Cell**

### **To implement the street vending act the following action has been taken:-**

- Chandigarh got 3rd rank in the country on the compliance Index on Street Vending Act, 2014.
- Launch of E-Sampark based street vendors for collection portal on 2nd April, 2018.
- A total Revenue of Rs. 11.39 crores have been collected from Chandigarh Aadhar based registered street vendors under SUSV Component of DAY-NULM.
- Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Bye-Laws 2018 were notified.
- Draw of lots have been conducted for allotment of vending site for registered street vendors in two phases i.e. 1st phase on 28.12.2018 to 30.12.2018 and 2nd phase on 05.01.2019 to 08.01.2019.
- Provisional Vending Certificates have been issued to approx. 1600 registered Street Vendors.
- An MOU has been signed on Pilot Project on Street Food Vending with the School of Public Health, PGIMER, Chandigarh for training purpose.

## **Fire Wing**

- The MC got passed the resolution from General House of MC to recover the huge expenses incurred by the fire Department on fire safety from owners/occupiers of building/ premises in lieu of inspection/Issuance of Fire Safety Certificate which was approved by H.E and conveyed by the Secretary, Local Government, Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh vide

his office letter no 2002-FII (9)-2018/21392 dated 21.11.2018. After implementation of above orders w.e.f. 21.11.2018, the Fire and Emergency Services collected the Fire Safety Charges amounting to Rs. 26,43,543/-, up to 31.03.2019.

- Purchased 28 nos Fire Proximity Suits Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and 01 Inflatable Emergency Lighting Tower to equip and strengthen the Fire department.

### **Parking**

After cancellation of contract of operation and management of 25 paid parking and 01 Multi level Parking with M/s Arya Toll Infra, Limited, for non payment dues on 18.02.2019, the MCC is managing all paid parking from its own staff for public. The total revenue receipt in respect of Paid Parking, Taxi Stand and Cable Operators for the financial year 2018-19 is Rs. 9,83,82591/- Rs. 65,90,486/- and Rs. 10,47,412/- respectively.

### **Colony**

The Colony Branch has collected a sum of Rs 1,94,67,028/- towards rent from the rehabilitated colonies situated at Vikas Nagar, MauliJagran, Sector 52-53, Chandigarh & Milk &Kumhar Colony and Village Maloya. Besides, a sum of **Rs. 6,12,68,183/- (Rupees Six Crore twelve lacs sixty eight thousand one hundred eighty three only)** has been received from the Estate Office, U.T., Chandigarh on account of payment of consolidated share of plinth sites of Sector 25 @ Rs. 133/- per site/per month.

### **OTHER ACHIEVEMENTS**

- In 2018-19, MC was facing severe financial crisis, all development works were halted and bills worth Rs. 30 Cr were pending. Financial strengthening was ensured by rational utilization of grants received and prioritizing the works. All revenue streams were tapped and an increase of around 16% was recorded in total revenue generation under various heads. Long pending arrears were recovered in campaign mode. Financial road map was prepared for MC. Got funds from UT Administration for various development works.
- Action Plan on Swacch Bharat Mission (SBM)got approved from High Powered Committee and submitted to GOI.
- To increase the revenue generation of MC, 28 Uni-poles got approved after constant follow up with CAUT.
- 2 new Petrol Pump sites were allocated to MC to improve the financial position.
- New Policy got notified for laying OFC cables and PNG network pipelines.
- Long pending issue of shifting of Car Bazar was sorted out by taking all stake holders on board.
- Proposal for construction of 6 Community Centers was sent to UT Administration.

- All properties of city got surveyed on GIS and online payment facility for property tax was started.
- 100 neighbourhood parks were earmarked as playing areas for children.
- One time settlement scheme got approved for unauthorized water connections.
- New Transport Branch got established in MC and management of all vehicles placed under it for better service and reduction in expenditure. Vehicle management software made compulsory for all vehicles.
- Twin bins and wheel carts got provided under CSR from GAIL worth approx. 1.5 Cr.
- Rs. 40 lakh Capex and 15 lakh of Opex got under CSR for reconstruction of Toilet block at Cremation Ground from Rotary club.
- On world Environment Day, a week long drive was conducted to clean N-Choe, which was appreciated by citizens.
- Water tariff was revised and sewerage cess was introduced to fill the gap of income and expenditure in Public Health Wing.
- Property tax was introduced on non-residential properties of 5 villages which got merged in MC.
- STP at Maloya got commissioned in record time to deal with sewerage of new EWS houses and villages.
- All Open House grievances of Raj Bhawan got redressed by regular monitoring and directions to field staff.
- All issues of Advisory councils were dealt promptly.
- Animal Birth Control (ABC) program was conducted effectively to reduce the issues of dog management.
- National Institute of Financial Management (NIFM) was engaged to guide MC in its financial management.
- Construction and Demolition waste processing plant was conceptualized and executed in the period of 9 months.
- Celebration of various functions on occasion of Independence Day, world Yoga Day etc.
- Special package of Rs. 25 Cr was prepared for village development and funds were provided by UT Administration.
- Many of service charges and fees were revised and provision of 10 % annual increase was made.
- Got approval from General House to impose Cow Cess and Electricity Cess.
- Under AMRUT, SLAP was revised and more than 80% progress was achieved. Pending funds got approved from MoHUA.
